



It is looked after by the Chairman of Course Committee, Senior Professors are the Academic coordinators of phase committees who maintain a constant monitoring of the ongoing academic activities. Student representatives are also member of the phase committees. They sit once in a month to fix the time schedule for in-course assessments. class routine and to decide on other issues related to academic purposes and students performances.

Disciplinary Committee

A strong disciplinary committee consisting of senior faculty members and senior members of the governing body to oversee discipline within the college campus.

CollegeAdministration

Principal is the administrative head of the college & guided by the Governing body in all administrative and financial matters. Chairman is the executive head of the Governing body. She guides the Principal in all relevant matters of the college. The Principal is advised by the Academic Council in academic matters. The college runs on self-financing and non-profit basis.

Principal along with the academic council looks after the human resource, management of the educational programs and maintains academic environment in the college. Chairman, Principal, Vice-Principal & relevant other officials run the administration.

Academic Council

The College Academic Council is formed by University of Dhaka and composed of the Principal, Vice Principal and all departmental heads & the senior faculty members ranging from Professor to Assistant Professor of all the departments as well as academic efficient personnels of the college & student representatives.

Academic Council is the highest decision making authority of the college, regarding all academic activities, administrative matters, and students' affairs.


